Dear Assisted Living Family Members,

As Colorado continues to ease pandemic restrictions, Kavod has also adjusted its protocols. In general, we will no longer require masks for fully vaccinated individuals starting Monday, June 28. This includes all visitors, vendors, construction workers, staff, and residents.

WHAT YOU SHOULD KNOW: Because the Assisted Living Program (AL) falls under the CDPHE's Public Health Orders, **all Assisted Living visitors who want to participate in the no mask order and avoid prescheduling visits MUST PROVIDE PROOF OF COVID-19 VACCINATION**. This documentation can be sent by fax or email prior to visiting. Our fax is 720.382.7845; email is CMartinez@KavodSeniorLife.org.

If you are unvaccinated, do not send proof of vaccination or choose not to share your vaccinated status, you will be required to continue to wear a properly-fitting mask, pre-schedule your visit, and be escorted to your visiting area. This requirement applies to visitors of any age.

Other protocols to note:

- Regardless of vaccination status, **all visitors must pass COVID-19 screening upon entry**. If you refuse to take part in screening, we are required to deny entry. If you do not pass the screening, we are also required to deny entry.
- If you are continually noncompliant with any mitigation measures, we are required to remove you.
- Visitors who preschedule visits due to the reasons listed above must remain in your car or outside the building until your scheduled visit time.
- **Visitors are asked to go straight to their destination apartment and directly outside after the visit**. All visitors are required to properly wash their hands before and during (as necessary) the visit.
- The **max visitors per resident at one time is two (2). Children of any age also count as a visitor**. There is no set limit of how many visits per day.
- Infection prevention protocols will still be observed on campus to ensure that we can continue to allow visits while keeping everyone as safe as possible as we move through this pandemic. This means that if our facility has state restrictions implemented due to increased COVID-19 cases, visitation may not be available. We will let you know if this situation happens.
